FOR GOOD - ETHICAL CAREERS POLICY

As an organisation that frequently acts as a bridge between students, graduates and third party organisations we take our responsibility to social and climate justice seriously, and strive to be selective about the organisations we do and do not work with.

For Good is a platform that explicitly seeks to facilitate collaboration that contributes to the betterment of society and the environment. Consequently, there are some industries that we see as fundamental barriers to a more just and sustainable world.

For Good will not hold relationships or collaborate with the following industries/companies on any of its workstreams. This includes, but is not limited to Research for Good, Placements for Good and Projects for Good.

- The oil industry
- The gas industry
- The mining industry, where complicit in environmental degradation and/or social conflict
- Companies involved in the manufacturing or transfer of weapons or other equipment that is used in the violation of human rights or supplied to oppressive regimes
- Companies involved in industrial agriculture
- Companies implicated in animal cruelty, including conducting animal testing for non-medical products
- Financial institutions funding, or investing in, any of the above
